Students enjoy a fast-paced tour of the steps to financial fitness and participate in hands-on activities that demonstrate the importance of wise financial planning. Students also consider the value of money and evaluate their own attitudes toward spending and saving. The workshop allows students to explore the importance of making wise money decisions even while they are teenagers
